Changes in AUFF funding instruments

Aarhus University Research Foundation (AUFF) has decided to terminate the instrument "Overgang fra ph.d. til postdoc" (seed money for PhD's in the period after defence). From 2013 funding for grants to the internationalisation of PhD education at AU will be administered by the heads of PhD Schools at faculty level. Grants for guest researchers, PhD courses or research retreats at Sandbjerg Manor are applicable at all times. Next deadline for the instrument 'Publications' is 18 February 2013". [Link](#)

AUFF has announced that a new call for AU Ideas will be published in the beginning of March. In 2013 50 million kr. is reserved for the initiative. Still two annual deadlines for DFF individual postdoctoral grants

Some researchers have contacted us with questions regarding the coming deadlines for individual postdoctoral grants. It has been a general misunderstanding that the instrument "individual postdoctoral grants" would only be applicable at the May deadline in the future. The DFF Secretariat has confirmed that there will be a deadline for postdocs in May and a main deadline including postdocs in November.

Career Integration Grant (People Programme/Marie Curie)

The CiG offers a great opportunity for researchers from abroad who have worked less than 12 months in Denmark prior to the deadline, or for heads of department/senior scientists who plan to attract a foreign researcher to a position at AU. Building on an individual "bottom-up" research plan, the grant provides the grantee with 25,000 € annually for a period of up to four years to boost their research career and ambitions.
