JPI Urban Europe - preannouncement

The Joint Programming Initiative (JPI) publishes a new call 18 June 2013. The focus is on research and innovation in the field of urban development. The topics are: 1) Governance of urban complexity and 2) Urban vulnerability, adaptability, and resilience. Up to 500,000 Euro for applicants from DK.

Deadline for stage I applications will be 18 September 2013.

Call for proposals with focus on designing, testing and/or promoting the spread of effective interventions within three policy areas: Social work, education and crime prevention. Max amount per project DKK 8 million. The projects are to be affiliated with the Trygfondens Barneforskningscenter.

Marie Curie Actions – gain experience abroad

Marie Curie Fellowships are European research grants available to researchers regardless of their nationality or field of research. There can be applied for research stays in another EU country (Intra-European Fellowship (IEF)), research stays outside EU (International Outgoing Fellowship (IOF)) and for researchers outside EU, who wants to spend time in EU (International Incoming Fellowship (IIF)).

Research development grants (Danida) – phase I applications

The call includes two types of grants with duration of up to 5 years and a max of DKK 10 million per project:

a) North Driven Development Research Projects with the themes: i) Governance in fragile and unstable environments; ii) Green economy, inclusive growth and employment; iii) Rights to natural resources

b) South Driven Development Research Projects: Ghana, Tanzania and Nepal – no themes.
